

## Woolly Cupgrass



Vegetative plant. Key characteristics: very dense, soft pubescence covers all plant surfaces. Often, there is a crinkle-like appearance on one side of each leaf blade margin. Inflorescence. Key characteristics: Upper surface of rachis covered with hair.



Seed. Seed are covered with short hairs, tipped with a cup-like appendage and are approximately 4.0 mm long.

Life cycle: summer annual.
